INSOLVENT ACT OF 1875 :—Bill No. 60. Mr. *Blake*, 107. Bill read second time, 144. Considered, and amended ; Motion that amendments be concurred in ; Messrs. *Gibbs* (South Ontario), *White* (Renfrew), and *Barthe's* amendments severally negatived on division. Amendments made in *Com.* were then concurred in pp. 229 to 232. Question for third reading—Mr. *Caron's* amendment negatived, Bill read third time—Motion that Bill do pass—Mr. *Goudge* moved that Bill be recommitted—Mr. Speaker ruled motion out of order, because at this stage a Bill cannot be recommitted—Bill was then passed, pp. 238 to 240.
