GENERAL ORDER.

The whole of the MILITIA FORCES throughout Lower-Canada are to be considered as commanded for service, and are to move forward to meet the enemy as they shall be required.

Lieut. Col. Deschambault is immediately to cross the St. Lawrence at La Chine to Cockawaga, with the following Battalions:—

La Pointe-Claire, Rivière du Chêne, Vaudreuil and La Longue-Pointe; and march with them upon l'Acadie.
