An Act to amend the Act “further to secure the Independence of Parliament.”

WHEREAS the Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the twentieth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, *An Act further to secure the Independence of Parliament*, requires amendment: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The seventh section of the said recited Act is hereby repealed.

2. Whenever any person holding any one of the following offices, that is to say: of Receiver General, Inspector General, Secretary of the Province, Commissioner of Crown Lands, Attorney General, Solicitor General, Commissioner of Public Works, President of Committees of the Executive Council, or Postmaster General, and being at the same time an Elective Member of the Legislative Council or a Member of the Legislative Assembly, shall resign his office, and immediately upon such resignation accept any other of the said offices, he shall not thereby vacate his seat in the Legislative Council or House of Assembly, any law, use or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.
