Neverthelest, in Cake the Public authorities should wish to be that Come through another Channel than My own aftertions, I shall dubnik with the greatest pleasure to any Enquiry that may be made on the Spok by Commissioners unconnected with this defaitment, but conversant with the Cuttoms and utages of the Indians: By this means I shall he able to prove to the general datis. - faction of all Concerned, that & always determed, and that do determe
