Parliament May Change Tariff Rates

Canada retains entire freedom to adjust the rates of the Intermediate Teriff in respect to all items not included in Schedule (1) of the Agreement. This Schedule comprises 180 items or less than 13% of the total number of items in the Canadian Tariff; in the case of
