"no man was to be allowed to

"be supplied with arms & powder
"of such quality as to be of service
"but that the arms were to be
"of the best quality - that the
"Government should supply the
"Indians with clothing - that the
"Government should supply the
"Indians with food - that the
"Government should supply the
"Indians with medicine - that the
"Government should supply the
"Indians with tools - that the
"Government should supply the
"Indians with everything they
"need for their subsistence
"and for the improvement of
"their condition."
