 the lease of the adjoining land
 and from the tenor of your
 letter these Messrs intend to store
 the grain taken from both farms
 in this barn, ^{thus} saving the necessi-
 ty of building a barn on the
 neighbouring lot, and storing
 the grain grown thereon at the
 expense of widow Mary Fisher.
