

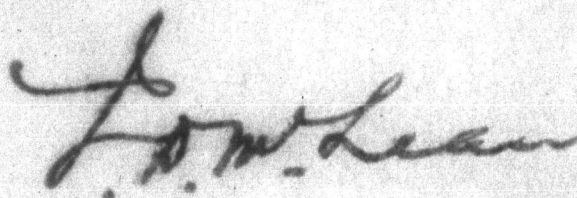
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Ottawa, 11th December, 1916.
