NOTE as per Auditor General's Report

At dissolution of Parliament on July 2, 1926, interim supply had been granted to the extent of one-fourth of the amount of the main estimates or sufficient to meet requirements to June 30th.

Between dissolution and the assembling of the new Parliament on December 9th, 1926, 7 warrants as above were issued for general services under all departments.

The remaining sixteen were for single or separate services.
