"I am B.100603 Corporal J A Dunn, orderly room Corporal of No 45 Cdn Gen Tpt Coy RCASC. I herewith produce as evidence three certificates concerning the apprehension and cost of return to unit of the accused, L.8794, Pte. L M Power, whom I now recognize. The first is a certificate of arrest signed by Major J. Paterson A.P.M. West Lancashire District; the second is CMHQ 1000:55, a certificate of expenses incurred in returning the accused from Liverpool to London; the third is CMHQ 1000:55, a certificate of expenses incurred in returning the accused from London to Three Bridges, the last two certificates were signed by Captain Fern of No. 6 Provost Coy, Cdn Provost Corps.
