acting ae repreaentative of the aforementioned Indians, to cut and deliver, $a s$ and where cut, to the Party of tlie secu nd Part, a. 11 of the merchantable timber on the said Harwoou $I_{\text {E }}$ land.
2. The party of the Second Part hereby agreee to pay to the Party of the Firet Part, at the rate of $\$ 1.75$ per thousand feet, for said timber so out and delivered, which is to provide for $75 \%$ per thousand, payable firect to the Indians, for work and labour performed in cutting and delivering said timber to the party of the second Part, and \$1.00 per thouaand the mount fixed by the Department to go to the oredit of the trust fund for the Sliammon Tribe of Inilans.
3. And it is further agreed and understood, that in the event $D \mathcal{E}$ the party of the First Part, not outting suffioient fimber to keep the equipment, winich the party of the seound perit ehall use in the removal of the said timber from the ground Wheze cut, in conetant operation, then the Farty of the second Part is hereby siven permiesion to assist the Indians in cutting the eaid timber for delivery, and any oharge for euch asifictance will be a matter or arrangement between the Indians themselvee, and the Pasty of the second Part direct.
4. The Party of the Second Part agrece to pay the eum of \$1.00 per thousand at the office of the Dominion Government situate inthe City of New Weatminetez, B, C, to the credit of the Party of the Firet Fart, on every boom of loee taken from the said Reserve Number Two, inmediately upon receipt of the seale as made by the Scaler of the Dominion Government as per reculations, and the remaining 75 per thousanc to the Incians of Sliammon Neect ve, ho have becn eneaged in the cutting of the said timber on Harwood Island.
