

acting as representative of the aforementioned Indians, to cut and deliver, as and where cut, to the Party of the Second Part, all of the merchantable timber on the said Harwood Island.

2. The party of the Second Part hereby agrees to pay to the Party of the First Part, at the rate of \$1.75 per thousand feet, for said timber so cut and delivered, which is to provide for 75¢ per thousand, payable direct to the Indians, for work and labour performed in cutting and delivering said timber to the party of the Second Part, and \$1.00 per thousand the amount fixed by the Department to go to the credit of the trust fund for the Sliammon Tribe of Indians.

3. And it is further agreed and understood, that in the event of the party of the First Part, not cutting sufficient timber to keep the equipment, which the party of the Second part shall use in the removal of the said timber from the ground where cut, in constant operation, then the Party of the Second Part is hereby given permission to assist the Indians in cutting the said timber for delivery, and any charge for such assistance will be a matter of arrangement between the Indians themselves, and the Party of the Second Part direct.

4. The Party of the Second Part agrees to pay the sum of \$1.00 per thousand at the office of the Dominion Government situate in the City of New Westminster, B.C., to the credit of the Party of the First Part, on every boom of logs taken from the said Reserve Number Two, immediately upon receipt of the scale as made by the Scaler of the Dominion Government as per regulations, and the remaining 75¢ per thousand to the Indians of Sliammon Reserve, who have been engaged in the cutting of the said timber on Harwood Island.
