William of Orange was one of the most noted of the Cruickshank bulls. He was a red, and was sired by Roan Gauntlet. He possessed, we are told in Shorthorn history, strong individuality, wonderful constitution, a grandly spread and admirably-covered back, and extraordinary quality; as a getter there were or are few better, as he sired Gay Monarch, Master of the Mint, and the dam of Marengo, Philo Mills' great bull. The daughters of the great Orangeman proved mines of wealth to the Uppermill people. Gondomar, the great-grandson of Judge, of the Greenway herd, is, as is to be seen, great-grandson of Scottish Canadian. Some of the prizes taken by the Oak Grove herd were for Scottish Canadian, in the three-year-old open class at Winnipeg, when he was second to Sittytown Hero 7th; he was also first and sweepstakes at Portage la Prairie, where he also headed the first-prize herd (Oak Grove). Scottish Boy was first and sweepstakes in the C. P. R. special class, 1903; while two of the matrons, Imogene and Siren 7th, were both winners; Imogene first and sweepstakes, Portage, in 1902, Siren 7th was the winner in the yearling C. P. R. class at Winnipeg, 1902, and in 1903 was fourth in the open class; Ruby Derocher 3rd won second as calf in the C. P. R. class. The home-bred (C. P. R.) young herd prize also going to the Oak Grove herd at Winnipeg, 1903. In a later issue the females will be reviewed. Send for catalogue to Jas. Bray, Longburn, Man. The station is Macdonald, C. P. 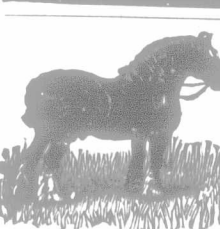
