KEPT IN PRISON. CREW OF WHALING SHIP INCARCERATED FOR FIVE YEARS. The Sailors Have Long Been Mourned as Dead—One Escaped to Kingston, B.W.I., Where He Told His Story.

Kingston, St. Vincent, B. W. I., May 5.—It may be that Captain Collin Stephenson and the crew of the American whaling ship Carrie D. Knowles, long since thought to have been lost at sea, are still alive in a Venezuelan prison. An American seaman, who gives the name of Payne, an escaped prisoner from Venezuela, has made his way to Kingston, where he had before the authorities an astounding story of the seizure of the Carrie D. Knowles at a Venezuelan port, where she arrived five years ago in distress, and the incarceration by Venezuelans of the captain and his men.

GUERIN GUILTY. Mysterious Death of Alex. Sutherland in Stratford. Stratford, May 5.—At the Spring Assizes being held here the jury pronounced Alonius Guerin guilty of manslaughter shortly before midnight. The case was one in which Alexander Sutherland of West Zorra was found dead at the rear door of Guerin's residence on Brunswick street, on the morning of February 27th last. Justice Riddell will sentence at 9 o'clock on Thursday morning.
