In case of a declination to sign British, French and American troops are prepared to take such steps as Marshal Foch may deem necessary while at sea the old blockade against Germany is ready to be tightened again. A plan of the Allies to have Switzerland, in the event of a refusal by Germany to sign, to enforce a more severe blockade against Germany, if necessary, is reported to have failed, Switzerland claiming this would infringe Swiss neutrality.

It had been believed possible that on Friday the terms of peace to Austria would be ready for submission by the Council of Four to the representatives of the smaller nations. however, has been found impracticable owing to the necessity to embody in the treaty the new agreement as re gards the Italian claim in the Adriatic region. 


