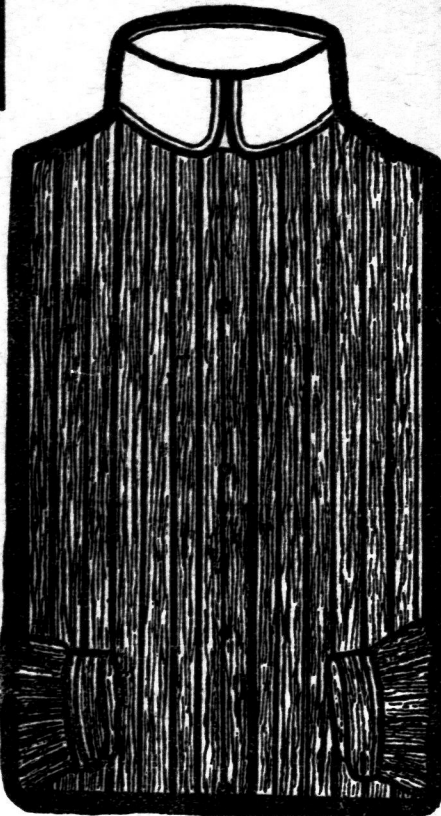

CHATHAM MUST GIVE UP FINES

Provincial Government is Now Anxious to Get Its Share of the Money.

[Special to The Advertiser.]

Chatham, May 13.—Police Magistrate Houston has been asked by the attorney-general of the province to report to him as to the disposition of the fines imposed by him in cases of assault. None of these fines have been paid. The council, after passing the resolution, discovered that the fines in cases of assault did not go to the city but to the treasurer of the province.
