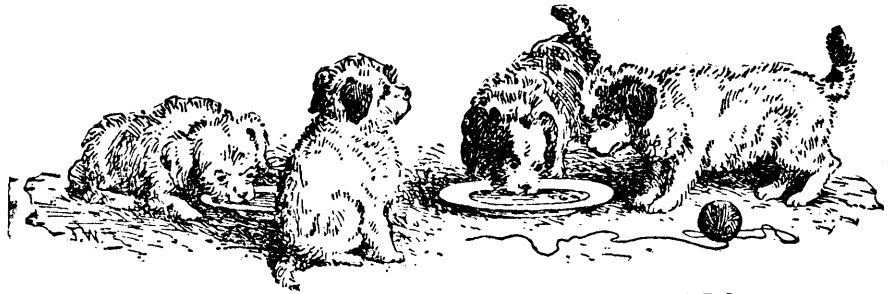
A commodious steamer runs daily during the tourist season, between Roberval and the Island House, at Grand Discharge, thirty miles distant.

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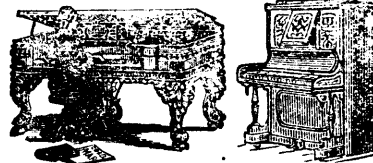

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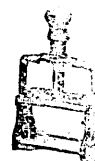
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
