The Bishop of Brisbane would bear him witness that in some of these eighty dioceses, several of which were as big as England, Wales and Scotland, many as large as England, and a large number as big as Ireland, if anything unusual or troublesome arose, they generally made up their minds to "ask Canterbury about it." (Laughter.) He assured them that most of the correspondence, which fifty years ago lay easily morning by morning in the bottom of a china bowl brought by a functionary with a gold band round his hat and a red collar, was now as much as four very industrious persons and himself could deal with.-The Church.
