Description:	<u>Investment</u> 1. Regulations made under the <i>Aeronautics Act</i> incorporate by reference the definition of "Canadian" found in the <i>Canada Transportation Act</i> . These Regulations require that a Canadian operator of commercial air services operate Canadian-registered aircraft. These regulations require an operator to be Canadian in order to obtain a Canadian Air Operator Certificate and to qualify to register aircraft as Canadian.
