

Mr. Ewan Nigel Hare (45) born in Southport, England, as Ambassador to Zaïre with concurrent accreditation to Rwanda.

Mr. Hare (B.A. History and Political Science, 1962; Graduate Diploma, Public Administration, Carleton University, 1964) entered the Federal Government in 1962. After serving on the the Treasury Board Staff, he worked in Malaysia with CUSO and returned to Ottawa to work with CIDA in 1966. He served in Ghana, and subsequently held positions as Regional Director, Asia Southeast; Regional Director, Central and Southern Africa; and Director General, Social Development Division. Mr. Hare will be leaving his current position as Director General, United Nations Programs, CIDA. He replaces Mr. J-G. Saint-Martin who is returning to Ottawa.

David Jackson who returns to Canada.
