Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Section ninety-nine of the British North America Act, 1867 Amendment as to tenure of office of Judges. 30 and 31. Vict., c. 3.

- "99.(1) Subject to subsection two of this section, the Judges of Tenure of the Superior, District and County Courts shall hold office during good office of behaviour, but shall be removable by the Governor General on Judges. Address of the Senate and House of Commons.
- (2) A Judge of a Superior, District or County Court, whether Termination appointed before or after the coming into force of this section, shall at age 75. cease to hold office upon attaining the age of seventy-five years, or upon the coming into force of this section if at that time he has already attained that age."
- 2. This Act may be cited as the British North America Act, Short title 1960, and the British North America Acts, 1867 to 1952, and this citation. Act may be cited together as the British North America Acts, 1867 to 1960.
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the first day of March, Commence-nineteen hundred and sixty-one."
