UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE—MATERNITY BENEFITS

Question No. 394—Mr. Cossitt:

With reference to maternity benefits permitted under the Unemployment Insurance Act, are such benefits permitted for those who adopt small babies considering the fact that adoption regulations require them to spend a certain number of weeks at the beginning at home with their child and, if not, will the government consider giving the same rights to a mother of an adopted child as to a natural mother of a child under the act?

Hon. Ron Atkey (Minister of Employment and Immigration): Section 30 of the Unemployment Insurance Act does not permit the payment of maternity benefits to adoptive parents. The issue of adoptive parents' eligibility for benefit is currently under review.
