FIRST SIDERUNT.

At the City of Toronto, and within St. Andrew's Church there, Wednesday, the Twelfth day of June, in the Year of Our Lord, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-nine, at half-past seven o'clock in the evening :—

Which time and place the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Canada met, in accordance with the appointment of last year's Assembly.

The Rev. William Thomas McMullen, D.D., the retiring Moderator, conducted Divine service, and preached a sermon from the Acts of the Apostles, the twentieth chapter and twenty-fourth verse, reading therewith the twenty-second and twenty-third verses, in these words : “ *But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the Gospel of the Grace of God.* ”

Dr. McMullen then, with solemn prayer, constituted the General Assembly in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, the only King and Head of the Church.
