Ymir

Formerly Quartz Creek, a town on Salmon River, about 18 miles from Nelson, Township 17, Lot 1,242, block 6, population between 500 and 600, is on the line of the Nelson & Fort Sheppard A.Y., and has depot, telegraph and express offices. The Wild Horse Creek, 15 miles in length, on which are situated the Ymir, Blackcock, Wilcox, Elise, and many other promising properties. Porcupine Creek, on which are the Porcupine, Blue-eyed Nellie, and others; Barrett and Stewart Creeks with the Porto Rico, and Quartz and Bear Creeks, are all tributary to this town, as well as the Dundee mine.

A lumber mill operated by Blue & Co., is in operation, and a water works system is under construction. The character of the properties varies greatly, the Dundee and Ymir being chiefly galena carrying large gold values, while the Porto Rico is a free milling proposition which so far has given excellent results.
