

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL SD-190.

An Act for the relief of Stella Liberman, otherwise known as Stella Silverman.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Stella Liberman, otherwise known as Stella Silverman, residing at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, wife of Michael Liberman, otherwise known as Michael Silverman, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the town of Montreal West, in the said province, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the twenty-fourth day of January, A.D. 1950, at the city of Tel Aviv, Israel, she then being Stella Fischer; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.
