O LORD God, who didst reveal Thyself to Thy prophet Samuel, while he was yet a child, grant to us, whom Thou hast made Thy children by adoption and grace, that we may attain to the knowledge of Thy will, and may pass all our days in obedience to Thy holy commandments; through Jesus Christ our Lord.
