SIR JAMES HENRY CRAIG, Knight of the most Honorable Order of the Bath, Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over the Provinces of Lower Canada, Upper Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and their several dependencies, Vice Admiral of the same, General and Commander of all His Majesty's Forces in the said Provinces of Lower Canada, and Upper Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and their several dependencies, and in the Island of Newfoundland, &c. &c. &c.

The Master, Deputy Master and Wardens of the Trinity House of Quebec having submitted for my Sanction and confirmation certain BYE-LAWS, Rules and Orders, by them made; ordained, and constituted, under and by virtue of an act of the Provincial Parliament intituled "an act for the better regulation of Pilots and Shipping in the Port of Quebec, and in the Harbours of Quebec and Montreal, and for improving the Navigation of the River Saint Lawrence, and for establishing a Fund for decayed Pilots, their Widows and Children;" and under and by virtue of an other Act of the Provincial Parliament, intituled, "An Act to amend an Act passed in the forty fifth Year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for the better regulation of Pilots and Shipping in the Port of Quebec and in the Harbours of Quebec and Montreal, and for improving the Navigation of the River Saint Lawrence and for establishing a Fund for decayed Pilots, their Widows and Children;" in the words following to wit;

BYE LAWS, RULES and ORDERS made, ordained and constituted by the Master, Deputy Master and Wardens of the Trinity House of Quebec, on Tuesday the ninth day of April, in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven.

SECTION 1st:

Bye Laws, Rules and Orders to be observed by Masters and Commanders of Ships and Vessels frequenting the Cul de Sac, and by others.
