

10. Birds known as perchers, such as swallows, king birds, warblers, flycatchers, woodpeckers, whip-poor-wills, finches, (song sparrows, red-birds, indigo birds, c&c.,) cow-buntings, titmice, goldfinches, grives, (robin, wood thrushes, &c.,) kinglets, bobolinks, grackles, grosbeaks, humming birds, cuckoos, owls, &c., except eagles, falcons, hawks and other birds of the falconidæ wild pigeons, king-fishers, crows, ravens, waxwings, (*récollets*) shrines, jays, magpies, sparrows and starlings.
- } From 1st March to 1st September

11. To take nests or eggs of wild birds. At any time of the year.

N B.—Fine of \$2 to \$100. or imprisonment in default of payment.

No person who is not domiciled in the Province of Quebec, can, at any time, hunt in this Province without having previously obtained a license to that effect from the Commissioner of Lands, Forests and Fisheries. Such permit is not transferable.
