Just here unforseen trouble arose from another source, owing to the sudden death of Major Russell's partner; and under the laws of Mexico, when a mine is shut down it cannot be started up again unless they have authority or permission from the others owners or from those holding balance of the interest. The deceased pantner's wife hailed for Europe and Major Russell was obliged to make four trips to Eusland before negotiations were completed and her interest in the property procured. 




