SUGAR IS AGAIN A FEATURE

Dominated Wall Street to Some Extent Yesterday.

Disappointment Over the Dividend—Canadian Securities Remain Quiet, But Steady for the Most Part—Railroad Earnings—Money Rates—Notes.

World Office, Tuesday Evening, Dec. 4. Canada securities today were quiet but steady.

C.P.R. showed the fourth week in November, \$31,000, a decrease of \$30,000 compared with corresponding week of 1900.

Toronto Street Railway earnings for the month of November were \$2,500, an increase of \$20,000 as compared with the corresponding month of 1900.

The earnings of Toronto Railway for week ended Dec. 1 were \$25,572, an increase of \$864.

Montreal Street Railway earnings for week ended Dec. 1 were \$35,120, an increase of \$274.
