PRINCE LOUIS OF BATTENBERG THE GUEST OF THE MAYOR AND CITIZENS OF ST. JOHN TODAY

His Serene Highness Arrived by Special Train from Halifax This Morning--Official Visits Exchanged With Mayor and Governor--Luncheon at Union Club an Elaborate Affair--How He Will be Entertained This Afternoon and Evening--The Warships in Port.

THE CIVIC ADDRESS

To His Serene Highness Prince Louis Alexander of Battenberg, G. C. B., Rear Admiral R. N., &c., &c.

Your Serene Highness-- The Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Saint John, on behalf of the Citizens, take great pleasure in extending to you a very hearty welcome to our City. Situated at one of the gateways of the Dominion of Canada, the extent of which you have recently had some opportunity of appreciating, the Terminus of one great Transcontinental Railway System, and soon to be that of another; at the mouth of a noble river, not inappropriately called the Rhine of America, we look forward with confidence and hope to the future. A Maritime community in every sense, our past has been intimately linked with the sea, and during the comparatively few years which have elapsed since our foundation, the Commerce of the British Empire has been carried in Saint John built-ships to all parts of the Globe. Under such circumstances it will be readily understood the deep interest and pride which we feel in the Sea Power of England, a protection alike to our homes and our trade, and it is with the highest satisfaction that we receive today in yourself and the officers and men under your command worthy representatives of the Royal Navy. THE PRINCE'S REPLY

Mr. Mayor and Gentlemen-- I thank you most heartily for giving me so warm a welcome in the City of St. John, which it gives me the greatest pleasure to revisit after a lapse of over thirty years. Great changes have taken place in the interval, which are characteristic of the universal development of the Dominion as a whole, the future extent of which no man would now be bold enough to foretell. In any case this kind of city as the place where the land and sea transport would be of little avail in themselves in keeping your territory inviolate, and insuring your sea-borne trade safe transit without the ubiquitous King's ships flying the white ensign. We who are the King's ships are gratified to find so much appreciation and glad at the opportunity of friendly meeting in time of peace. On behalf of the officers and men under my command I thank you heartily.

FAMINE AND REVOLUTION THREATENING RUSSIA

Country Isolated from Rest of Europe--Food Scarce and High--Thousands on Strike--A Reign of Terror is Feared.

ST. PETERSBURG, Oct. 26, 1.15 p. m. --Russia is practically isolated today from the rest of the continent of Europe, as the international train service on all the lines has virtually ceased. The tie up in the interior is more complete than yesterday. The only trains running are operated by the railroad battalions. The strike contagion is spreading. All classes of workmen are organizing sympathetic strikes and industrial life in the country is coming to a standstill. The situation cannot long continue. Either the workmen will soon be starved into submission or pillage with military interference will be resorted to on a large scale are bound to follow. At Moscow cabinet have already fought the strikers whom they charge with taking the bread out of their mouths. In many cities, especially at Moscow, the question of food is becoming extremely serious. Collisions between troops and strikers are reported to have occurred at several places. At Ekaterinod a regular pitched battle between the soldiers and strikers was fought, and the city was left in darkness. But as a rule the revolutionary leaders were keeping their men in hand, communication by telegraph with many true points is interrupted. The whole country is becoming alarmed and in St. Petersburg panic prevails. The boats and the Finnish trains, now the only means of travel, are crowded with people going abroad. The situation here has grown much worse over night. The ranks of 60,000 workmen in the mills and factories who

THE WARSHIPS ARRIVE

The warships Cornwall and Berwick arrived off Partridge Island this morning at 7.15 o'clock from Halifax and came into the harbor at 10 o'clock. Harbor Master Capt. John Ferris boarded the ships off the island at 8.30 and directed them to their mooring places in the harbor. The flag ship, Cornwall, is off the new city wharf, and the Berwick is below Reed's Point wharf. A large crowd of citizens lined the wharves along the harbor front to see the big ships come into port. After they anchored in the stream many small boats flocked around the ships; then the launches of both vessels were seen going to land from the shore and the harbor presented a pretty sight. It is stated that the run around from Halifax to within fifteen miles of Partridge Island was made in fifteen hours by both vessels which were in constant communication with the Marconi wireless station on Partridge Island. H. M. S. Cornwall and Berwick are the largest war ships that have ever visited the port. Visitors will be allowed on board the war vessels this afternoon. The city is full of visitors today. Every train arriving here was crowded.

CAUSE FOR THANKSGIVING.

The address to Prince Louis was safely presented this morning. The utmost care had been taken to guard it from being stolen by designing newspaper men, who have spent most of their time around City Hall for days past, trying to get next to it. The common clerk has been wearing Revolvers in his belt and knives in his boots, and the approaches to the Sacred Document were guarded by Argus-Eyed Officials. Never in the history of the city have such precautions been taken to balk a Dastardly Scheme of the reporters, because never before did so much depend on the issue. If anybody had seen that Address in advance, or got a copy of it, the Prince would undoubtedly have ordered the Cornwall and Berwick to bombard the town. Happily the reporters were foiled, the Sacred Document is now in the Prince's possession, to be to him a Talisman and an ever present help in time of trouble. The citizens owe a large Debt of Gratitude to the City Hall Official for their receipt this evening in the uniform he wore at the time of the Fenian Raid, but

AT CITY HALL

At twelve o'clock the Prince, accompanied by Flag Lieutenant Howbery, was driven to the City Hall, while Prince William strewed was lined with citizens. The City Hall had been well cleaned for the occasion, and after the Prince and his Flag Lieutenant descended from the balcony they ascended the stairs to the mayor's apartments. There the mayor greeted the visitors and there were present Recorder Skinner, High Sheriff Ritchie, the city's engineer, the common clerk and Aldermen Bullock, Frink, Hamm, Holders, Lewis, MacIsaac, McDermid, McArthur, Pickett, Spool, Tilly, and Vanwart. Aldermen Baxter, Christie and Millidge were absent owing to illness. The mayor read the address, after which he presented to the Prince. The latter then replied and handed it to the mayor, after which the mayor introduced the Prince to the above mentioned officials. When the Prince had been introduced to Alderman Lewis, he asked the latter if he did not remember when he was in this city thirty years ago with Admiral Fawcett. PAID SIXTY-ONE DIRECT

Another paragraph charges Gallery with paying direct to sixty-one persons whose names are given, various sums for the purpose of securing votes, treating voters, persuading electors and carrying voters to the polls. The names of a hundred and ninety voters are given to whom it is charged money or liquor was given, positions were given or promised and money lent to voters to vote or abstain from voting as the respondent and his agents wished. Forty-eight persons are named as those to whom money was supplied to persuade voters, and it is charged that 42 attempts at persuasion were made, in some cases two false votes being cast for one person, while in a small number of cases the attempt at persuasion was defeated because the personate would not take the oath. Among those whose names are given as having been presented are the late W. W. Ogilvie, Justice Baby and other men whose names are well-known throughout the city.

WOULD PAY THEM ALL

Then came the personal charges. Jas. Hector is said to have got a suit of clothes for working in the St. Maurice-street committee rooms. Ald. Gallery is charged with having given money to Jas. O'Grady, or endorsed that gentleman's vote to start a butcher's stall. Michael Mead is said to have received various sums for illegal and corrupt purposes. Arthur Cherry, foreman for Cunningham and Wells, is said to have received \$400 direct from Ald. Gallery for use in various ways in promoting the election of the respondent. John Henry is said to have received money to treat voters in Mrs. Harvey's barroom the night before the election. Ald. Gallery is also charged with having told Dan Donnelly, who approached him to secure work, 'I will pay every d--n man who will work for me,' and this in the presence of a number of electors, some of whom are named.

POSITIONS OFFERED

The member for St. Ann's is also charged with having secured the vote and influence of Thomas Murphy by giving him a job on the Curran bridge; of having, in connection with Ald. M. J. Walsh, his agent, caused the City of Montreal to pay time for men they employed working for Ald. Gallery's election to the house of commons, and it is further alleged that he gave money to Larry Rossier to treat voters at the saloon kept by Alex. Woods. Ald. Gallery is also charged with giving a Mrs. Deragon money for her husband, Frank Deragon, and her son, both electors, so that they could buy the vote and influence of four electors who are named, and it is further charged that Frank Deragon telegraphed several voters. Among other inducements which Ald. Gallery is said to have used to secure votes and influences are the following: A position at the Mill street fire station for John Kill-fisher; \$25 paid personally to Charles Mirron, 131 Wellington street, a job on the canal for W. O'Brien, a job as lockman for one Hart, and a job as policeman for Henry Meahan, with the promise of a permanent job from the government; a job for Daniel Demers from the government an appointment as snow foreman; reinstatement on the police force for John Collins; personally and through Ald. Walsh secured reinstatement in the fire department for Frank Dwyer.

COST MONTREAL ALDERMAN \$10,000 TO WIN ELECTION?

Ald. Gallery Accused of Bribery, Personal and Through Agents, to Influence Voters and to Secure Compensation--Many Cases of Impersonation Cited.

MONTREAL, Oct. 26--The statement was made some time since that the evidence forthcoming in the case of Ald. Dan Gallery, M. P., from St. Albans would be sufficient to hang an ordinary man.
