

SPECIMENS OF TYPE USED IN THE SOCIETY'S BIBLES AND TESTAMENTS.

DOUBLE PICA TYPE

LONDON.

O give thanks unto the LORD, for *he* is good: for his mercy endureth for ever. *Psaln cvii. 1.*

OXFORD.

O give thanks unto the God of gods: for his mercy endureth for ever. *Psaln cxxxvi. 2.*

ENGLISH TYPE

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. *John iii. 16.*

PICA TYPE

And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. *Rev. xx. 13*

SMALL PICA TYPE

O Zion, that bringest good tidings, get thee up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, that bringest good tidings, lift up thy voice with strength; lift it up, be not afraid, say unto the cities of Judah, Behold your God! *Isai. xl. 9.*

BREVIER TYPE

And they came to a place which was named Gethsemane: and he saith to his disciples, Sit ye here, while I shall pray. *Mark xiv. 32.*

MINION TYPE

Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. *Isai. lv. 7.*

NONPAREIL TYPE

Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. *Prov. iii. 6, 6.*

PEARL TYPE

How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth! *Isai. lxi. 7.*

RUBY TYPE

I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the Lord. Our feet shall stand within thy gates, O Jerusalem. *Psaln cxviii. 1, 2.*

DIAMOND TYPE

Get the word of Christ ab all in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing the psalm in your hearts to the Lord. *Colossians iii. 16.*
