

republics. Moreover, if Canada is concluded, there will arise the delicate question of what to do about some other countries, such as British Guinana, French Guiana and Dutch Guiana. Exactly where to stop if the policy of including republics only in the invitations is abandoned is difficult

to 'say. Another phase of the matter is the Another phase of the matter is that there is some delicacy felt by the Pan-American Union about inviting Canada unless it is done through Great Britain. And here comes up the question as to how the British government would view the association of one of its great dominions with an organization of re-

ublies. In past years, it is learned, the ques-tion of inclusion of Canada in the Pan-American Union has been much dis-cussed unofficially by influential men in the organization and outside of it. Officially, however, it never got any-where for the reasons already indicated. In view of the growing importance of Canadian trade with Latin America and with the United States, it has to be ad-mitted that the reason for including Can-ada are stronger now than many years ago, when the union was formed. It would be entirely natural if the question
