All Quiet in Sydney Strike Area During The Night.

Picketing Activities Interfered With by Heavy Rain - London, Ont., Troops Being Held at Disposal of Town Authorities.

(By Canadian Press Staff Correspondent.)

Sydney, N. S., Aug. 21. — Although practically all the maintenance men in Cape Breton South went back to work at the power house, pumps and fans, on Saturday and Sunday, full maintenance operations have not yet been resumed at several places, including the main power house at No. 2. New Aberdeen, where the military garrison is stationed.

The reason for this is that it has required some time to get things working after the almost complete shutdown of the last six days. It is expected, however, that full steam will be available at No. 2 and other centres this afternoon, when the work of pumping out the pits can be vigorously prosecuted.

Through some error in transmission of orders from U. M. W. headquarters the Sydney mines maintenance were not notified of the decision to return to work pending a conference with the company, and the pumpmen there were still out this morning.

Dublin, Aug. 21—An attack by Irish irregulars last Friday on the automobile generally used by Michael Collins, head of the provisional government, and commander of Free State forces, was reported in an official communication issued yesterday. Dublin Aimost Deserted.

Dublin, Aug. 21—The notice of the government garrison of Dublin to keep indoors Saturday night generally was obeyed. Very few persons ventured out, and the theatres and moving picture shows were almost deserted.

The expected attack by the irregulars did not inaterialize and except for the usual sniping the night passed quietly. Shortly after noon yesterday heavy machine gun, rifle and revolver firing was heard. It was stated that snipers were at work and that the National troops replied with machine guns and riffes. The fusillade continued for some time.

Paris, Aug. 21—The allied conference on the Turco-Greek problem probably will be held in some Italian city within the next six weeks as the result of a note from the British government received at the French foreign office today. The note is in response to a French communication of Aug. 3, suggesting a conference of the allies in which Turkish and Greek representatives would be admitted on an equal basis.


