Paris, March 14.—One of the most picturesque criminal careers on record has come to an end at the lie de Reconvict prison, on the Bay of Biscay, with the death of Baptistin Travall, who was recently sentenced to ten years' imprisonment as a member of the notorious bandit gang of La Villette. Among the exploits of this expert French cracksman were the holding up of the Indian mall train between Paris and Marseilles, and a theft of 200,000 francs from the strong-room of an ocean liner. But Travail had at any rate two redeeming features—patriotism and courage in his country's service, for on one occasion he exercised his criminal skill in the cause of France and her Allies.

It was an enterprise which none but the most expert criminal could have carried out, in which discovery mean large monetary reward for havig succeeded in it he refused to take a penny. Luring the war he was at Berne, where he came into contact with enemy spies and with the counter-esplonage service.
