MARSETILES, Feb. 10.—Two youths of Marseilles became smitten with the charms of certain members of the corps of English ballet girls now appearing in this city. Their advances being rejected, they decided to kill themselves.

One youth put a bullet through his heart then and there. The second attempted to shoot himself, but broke a window with a bullet that he had intended to shatter his head. His parents, learning of the affair, had him interned in a house of correction in Touraine. There, ten days after his arrival, he hanged himself in a cell, after writing a letter to his mother, in which he declared that he could not live without the love of the English girl.

The lad's suicide brought to light the fact that he had been received at the house of correction without a magistrate's order, and the sequel is that the superintendent of the institution, a retired army officer, is to be presecuted
