Copies or Extracts of the Official Communications which may have taken place between the Secretary of State and the Provincial Government of *Upper or Lower Canada*, relative to the destruction of the Settlement on the RED RIVER, to any legal Proceedings thereon in the Courts of *Upper or Lower Canada*, or to any Complaints made of those Proceedings by Lord *Selfkirk*, or the Agents of *The Hudson's Bay* or the *North-West* Companies;—also, for Copies or Extracts of the Reports made by the Commissioners of Special Inquiry, appointed to inquire into the Offences committed in the *Indian Territory*, so far as the same can be made public without prejudice to the Public Service, or to judicial Proceedings now pending in *Canada*.
