An Act to legalize certain proceedings of the Municipal Council of the County of Chambly.

W HEREAS the petition of the Municipal Council of the County of Preamble. Chambly represents, that doubts exist as to the legality of the proceedings of the said Council, established in virtue of the Lower Canada 18 V. c. 100. Municipal and Road Act of 1855, inasmuch as the said proceedings and 5 transactions were adopted and had during sessions of the said Council held at places which had not been fixed upon by the said Council according to the formalities required by the said Lower Canada Municipal and Road Act of 1855, and also inasmuch as certain of the said proceedings and transactions were adopted and had at a period subsequent to that 10 prescribed by the law: And whereas the said Council have, by their said petition, prayed that an Act might be passed to remove any doubts which might exist with respect to the said proceedings and transactions, and to legalize the same, and it is expedient to grant their prayer, and remove the said doubts, and render valid the said proceedings and transactions; 15 Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

1. All the proceedings and transactions adopted by the County Council Proceedings of of Chambly shall be held to be valid and in conformity with the law, notwithstanding that the sittings of the said Council shall have been held at places which had not been fixed in accordance with the formalities prescri-20 bed by the said Lower Canada Municipal and Road Act of 1855, and notwithstanding that certain of the said proceedings and transactions took place at a period subsequent to that prescribed by the said Act.

II. This Act shall be a public Act.
