## An Act to facilitate the Examination of Candidates for admission to the Notarial Profession in Lower Canada.

TATHEREAS great inconvenience and useless expense are occasioned Preamble. to candidates for admission to practise as Notaries in Lower Canada, from the fact of their articles of clerkship frequently expiring a few days only after the meeting of the Board of Notaries of their Dis-5 trict, thereby obliging them to wait for a period of three or four months after the expiration of their term of service in order to present themselves for examination : Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :
