

same spirit, informing you, however, that, in all matters, excepting the location of your Reserves I can only listen to your complaints and represent them faithfully to the Government with such remarks thereon as I may think called for under the circumstances.

I have no power to remedy any complaints that you may make as to the manner in which the Treaty has been carried out, but will not fail to represent your wishes to the Government.

With this view as you will observe a gentleman has taken notes of your complaints.

These I shall lay before the Minister.
