Dear Mr. Caldwell:

We will be very glad to take up the matter of the Coococache Indian Reserve with the Hon. Mr. Mercier, Minister of Lands and Forests as soon as you have advised us of the area and where the Indians desire for a new reservation. I would suggest that you ask the Indians to make two or even three choices in case the Department is unwilling to grant them their first request. I think it would be much better for all concerned if a representative of your Department could ascertain direct from the Indians their three choices. May we count on your having this done soon?
