not be prohibited under conditions as set forth in the Indian Act, I beg to inform you that mesfar as the country on the Sackatchewan is concerned hotices signed by the Superintendent Seneral of Indian Affairs prohibitory of the sale of fixed ammunition and ball cart. ridge to Indiana were forwarded to Ma Commissioner Dewoney on the 26 th alltime and he acknowledge the receipt of the same on the ofter Instant.

2nd With regard to the improved weapone in the hands of Indiana in the north- West Mrs Dewoney was authorized sometime ago to endeavour to induce the Indians to exchange the same for ordinary shot gume.
