
Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 28th March last, No. 81-26, I beg to enclose herewith a copy of a letter from Mr. Agent J.P. Wright relating to his valuation of the Right of way of the Canadian Northern Railway through the Fort Frances Agency Reserve.

In view of the statements made by the Agent it would appear that his valuation should be accepted. Will you kindly inform the Company that in view of the explanation made by Mr. Agent Wright, it is thought that the Company should pay his full valuation namely, \$3730.00 for the land, \$700.00 for the buildings, and \$100.00 for the garden, making a total of \$4530.00.

With reference to the buildings it is to be noted that although they are not actually situated on the land required by the Company for Right of way, they are so close to it that they will require to be removed; the Agent has placed the sum of \$700.00 above mentioned as damages on this account.
