Sir,

The Department has an application from Mrs. Magrath, wife of the Missionary at Griswold, for the position of teacher of the Oak River school and it has been decided to try the experiment of re-opening this school under charge. She will be paid an initial salary of \$300.00 per annum.

I would ask you to have the school ready for occupation with the least possible delay. If any repairs of an extensive kind are required authority should be received before any expenditure is made.

A requisition for the necessary school supplies should also be forwarded to the Department.

The Department trusts that you will use every endeavor to assist Mrs. Magrath in making the school a success. You will be good enough to submit monthly reports upon the work and a supply of blank forms for this purpose is being sent you under separate cover.
