Dear Sir, -

I have received your letter, not dated, in reply to mine of the 23rd ultimo.

At the time of your interview with me at Ottawa I agreed on behalf of the Department to relinquish all claim to the portion of Lot 160 claimed by you, and the Agent was at once communicated with to this effect and asked to inform the Indians accordingly; at the same time you stated that you would have no difficulty in arranging any matter of compensation satisfactorily with these Indians, and it is this statement that the Department now expects you to implement. If you do so I am quite sure that there will be no further difficulty.
