Under the circumstances you should endeavour to have some person other than reter capilla attend to the work. The cost in the past has been altegether too high, and economy must be practised. It is thought that if you make enquiries and do what you can in the matter you will be able to have the work attended to satisfactorily in return for the payment allowed.
