

CONFISCATION OF FARMS

The German Committee of the United States Senate on German Propaganda and Bolshevism says that if the Bolsheviks secure control of the United States, they will expropriate Russian millions of farmers would be a private property right of participation in the affairs of the Government, and the entire rural population of the population would be subjected to special repression of the Government. Under the revolution, the voting system of the Government would be changed, and the rural communities would be subjected to the same treatment as cities, from 25,000 or more population, which would be subjected to every 125,000 of the population. Under the United States the rural population under the Government was confined to the same as the cities of the nation.

It would result in the confiscation of the Government thus constituting a total of the United States, including 6,361,502 farms, of which 62.1 per cent, or 3,948,722 farms, are now owned by the farmers who cultivate them and produce the food and the raw materials. On the farms of the United States, there are improvements, machinery, and livestock, of the value of \$49,091,449,090 (evening of 1910), all of which would be confiscated and the land.

RUINATION OF INDUSTRY

"Confiscation, under the motto of nationalization, has eliminated from all industrial establishments, such as factories, mills, and mines, the business system and scientific methods necessary to successful operation and constructive method. It has been followed by the stagnation of the industry of the country, and even those nationalized industries which have been able to overcome under Government control, have operated at an enormous percentage of loss."

LIFE INSURANCE RENDERED VALUELESS

"One of the most important and far-reaching consequences of an application of Bolshevism to the United States would be found in the confiscation and nationalization of its life insurance companies. * * * Almost 50,000,000 life insurance policies, representing to any \$30,000,000,000 of insurance, the substantial protection of the women and children of the nation, would be rendered valueless."

"Complete control of all banks, institutions, and their assets is an essential part of the Government's revolutionary programme, and the 31,192 banks of the United States would be taken over by the Government and the savings of millions, including \$1,307,553 deposits, drawings, interest on accounts in savings banks, and consequently belonging to the so-called bourgeois or capitalist class, jeopardized."
