

## CONFISCATION OF FARMS

The minority committee of the United States Senate on German Propaganda and Bolshevism says that if the Bolsheviks secure control of the United States, they would, in Russia, millions of farmers would be deprived of their right of participation in the affairs of the government and the rural population, the poorer portion of the population would be subjected to socialist requisitioning and taxation. Under the revolutionary regime, in the voting districts the land would be confiscated as a matter of fact, and rural communities, regardless of the size, would be sent from an average of 1,400 to even 25,000 acres of property which each voter in the rural district would be entitled to every 1/5th of the property in the rural areas. In the United States the rural population under the 1910 census was considered in excess of the urban.

This would result in the confiscation by the Government thus constituting the Government of the United States of nearly 6,361,502 farms, of which 62.4 per cent., or 3,948,722 farms, are now owned by the farmers who cultivate them and represent the 16 percent of the total. On the farms of the United States there are improvements, machinery, and live stock of the value of \$16,493,449,000 (census of 1910), all of which would be confiscated by the Government.

## RUINATION OF INDUSTRY

"Nationalization, under the ministrations of nationalization, has eliminated from all industrial establishments, such as factories, mills, and mines, the business, financial and scientific methods necessary to successful operation and competitive methods. This has been followed by the stagnation of the industrial life of the country, and even those unnationalized industries which have been able to escape under Government control, have operated at an enormous loss, and at a loss."

## LIFE INSURANCE RENDERED VALUELESS

"Out of the vast stampeding and discrediting consequences of an application of Bolshevik socialism in the U.S. it would be found in the confiscation and nationalization of its life insurance companies. Almost 56,000,000 life insurance policies, representing to day \$30,000,000,000 of insurance, the substantial protection of the workers and children of the nation, would be rendered valueless."
