

No single Money Order, payable in the Dominion of Canada, can be issued for more than \$100, but as many of \$100 each may be given as the remitter requires

The other countries and British colonies upon which Money Orders are granted are distinguished by an asterisk (*) in the Foreign Postage table; the rates of commission in all cases being as follows :
