BOSTON OFFICE SPA

Boston, Mass., July 2.—In view of the fact that the Boston business and financial buildings are remaining well occupied, Real estate men think that the vacant space averages 10 per cent. as compared with 15 per cent. in the 1907 period.

Most of the modern buildings have been built in the last few years, and the amount of space under construction is small. An illustration is the \$1,100,000 extension of the State Mutual Building, which was completed in 1913.

Large investments are represented by the \$1,200,000 extension of the State Mutual Building in 1913. The low percentage earnings are influenced by the fact that rentals in the case of each property include a substantial amount of interest on the mortgage to represent the space it occupies in the building.
